

FINDING DIGITAL NEWSPAPERS AT THE WELLESLEY FREE LIBRARY

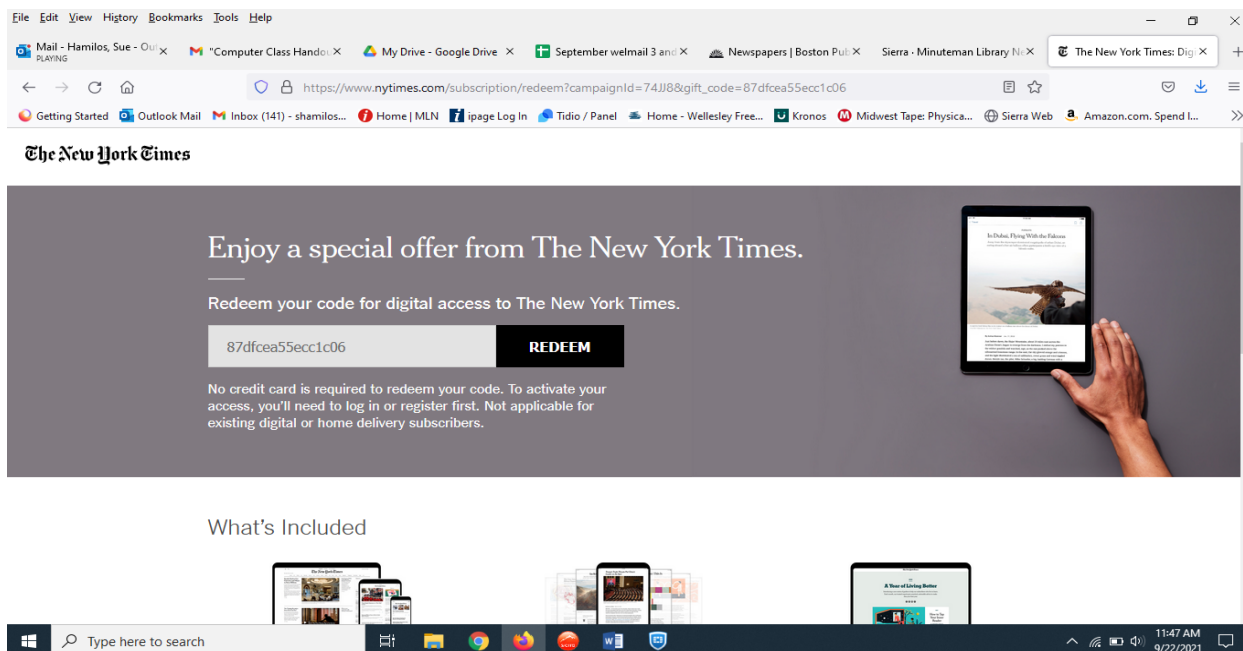
The WFL is happy to offer many options for digital newspapers available 24/7 from anywhere with an internet connection to our residents using their library cards. Some of the options include a reproduction of the current newspaper edition. Others offer searchable text articles with no images.

At the end of this session, participants will be able to

- Locate newspapers on the WFL website <https://www.wellesleyfreelibrary.org/>
- Access newspapers on Databases A-Z pages (alphabetical <https://www.wellesleyfreelibrary.org/digital-resources/databases-a-z/> and by Subject https://www.wellesleyfreelibrary.org/research_trashed/databases/)
- Sign up for access to current edition reproduction newspapers as well as view articles in text only newspapers
- Discover tutorials on *Niche Academy*

I. Current newspapers with page reproductions

[NYTimes.com Online](https://www.nytimes.com) (App available) Instructions are on the WFL webpage under E-Library/Digital Services/NYTimes.com (<https://www.wellesleyfreelibrary.org/use-nytimes-com/>). You cannot use the code if you already have a paid NY Times subscription. You have access to the current edition including Sundays and unlimited articles including archive for 72 hrs. New York Times Mobile App is available. International Edition is default.



- Connect to <https://www.wellesleyfreelibrary.org/>
- Click on E-Library/Digital Services/NYTimes.com Home...
- Click on Redeem
- Create an account with email address and password (or login if you already have an account)
- Confirmation Page appears and email sent to you telling you when your 72 hr access ends
- Repeat the process to renew your access.

TASK 1: Set up an account with NYTimes.com

Wall Street Journal (App available) How to Use WSJ.com

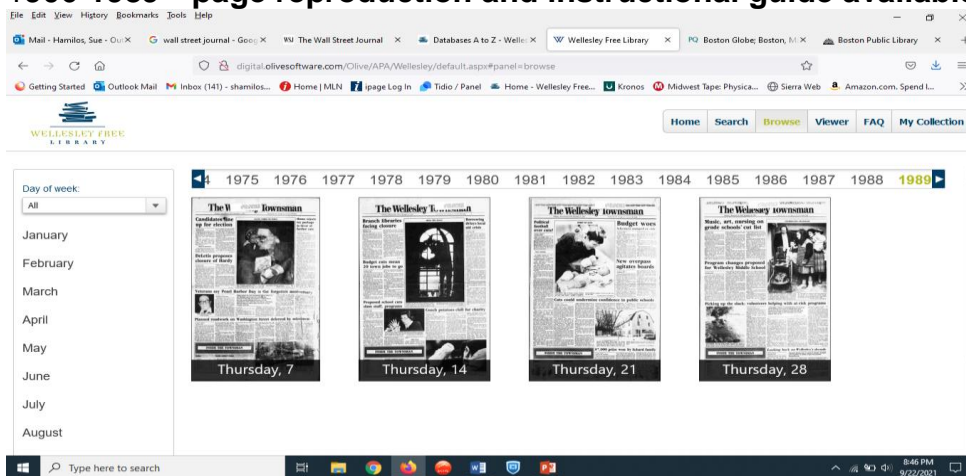
- Connect to <https://www.wellesleyfreelibrary.org/>
- Click on **E-Library/Digital Services/WSJ.com Home Access**
- Fill out form for an account or click Sign In if already have one
- Confirmation Page appears and email sent to you telling you when your 72 hr access ends.
- Click on Print Edition under Wall Street Journal Banner.
- Scroll down to WSJ.com eReader
- Click on Read WSJ Print Edition to display the page images of the newspaper
- Enjoy for 72 hours and then repeat the process to continue to access
- To print, use index and click on the article you would like and it will appear in the box to the right. Click on the print icon. View, print, email, download in the Index mode.
- You can download a page or the entire edition of the newspaper in the Index

TASK 2: Set up a WSJ Account

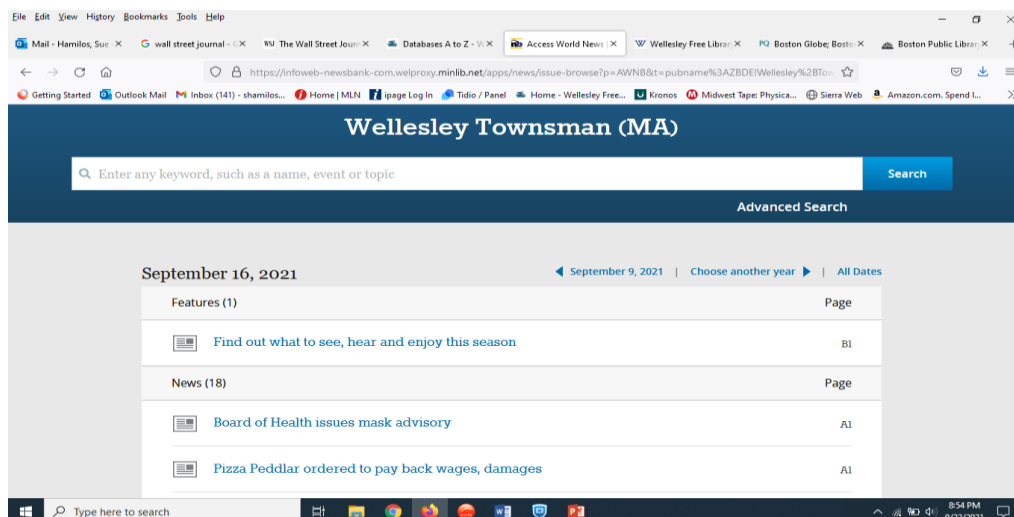

- **1906-1989—page reproduction and instructional guide available**

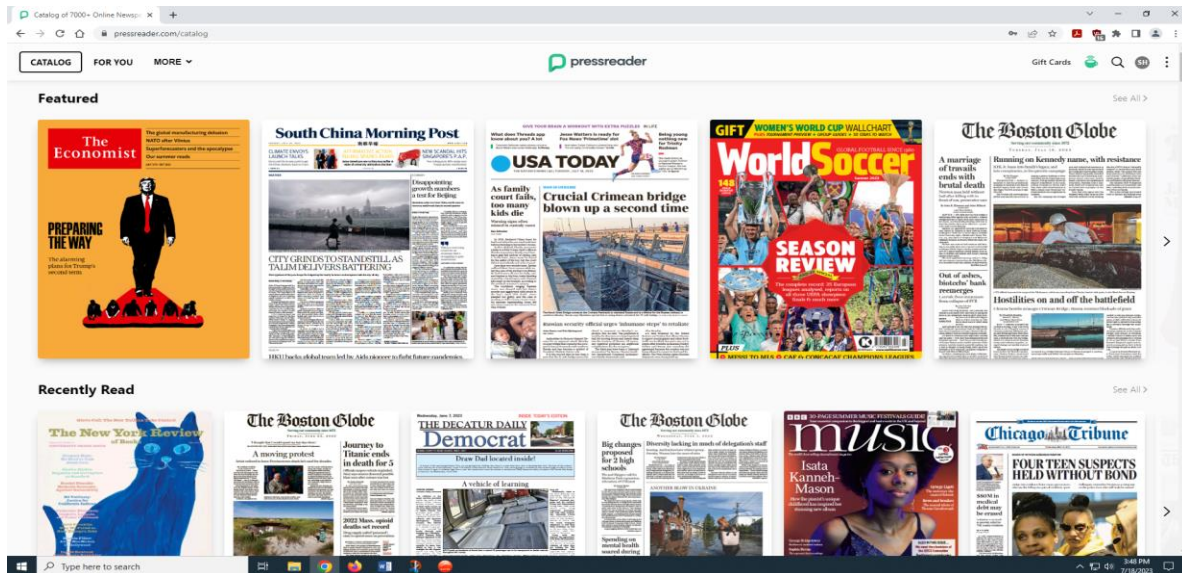


- **Newsbank 2005-Current (through Newsbank)—text articles only**

PressReader (App Available)



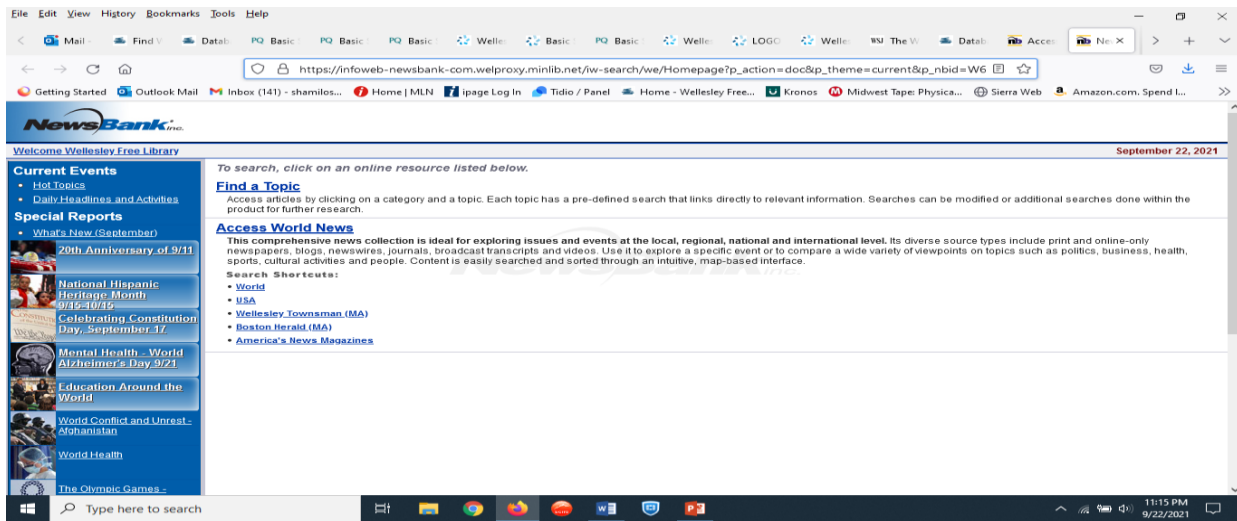
- Over **7000 daily newspapers/magazines** from **120 countries** (Including US Cities—LA, NY, Chicago, Washington DC, etc) (Of note are ***Boston Globe*, *USA Today*, *Christian Science Monitor Weekly*, and *Economist***)
- Multiple languages
- Customizable
- No limits on usage
- Read instantly or download for later usage
- Use on up to 5 devices
- Limit catalog by country, language, category
- Will translate and read the articles
- Set up alerts

- ***Boston Globe*** (Proquest) 1980-Current
- ***Boston Globe Historical*** (Proquest) 1872-1981
- ***New York Times Historical*** (Proquest) 1851-2015
 - All Proquest Databases have research accounts to save articles and searches)
 - Access to other historical newspapers—***Christian Science Monitor*; *LA Times*, *San Francisco Chronicle*, *Wall Street Journal*, *NY Times*, *Washington Post***
 - Basic & Advanced Search, Topic Finder, Subject Guide, Publication Search
 - Can search across all Proquest databases

- **Newsbank Access World News** (including MA newspapers such as ***Boston Herald***, ***Metrowest Daily News***, ***Atlantic***, ***National Review***, ***New Republic***, ***Newsweek***, local newspapers, & many more—10612 sources)

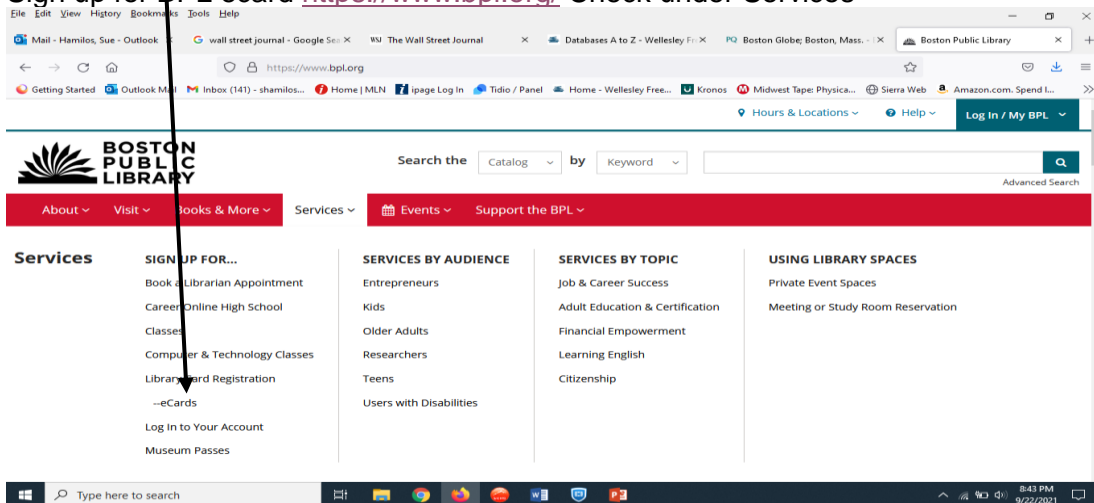


- World News

- Browse topics or search by keyword—Basic or Advanced Search
- Refine by Source Map, date, source name, source type
- Email, Print, Download or save articles to a Personal Folder you create
- Will read articles
