The Wellesley Free Library now offers access to a Bloomberg Terminal, the gold standard for financial information and research. Bloomberg Terminals are typically found at universities and within the financial industry, offering powerful tools for business professionals, students, and researchers. Thanks to the generous support of the Wellesley Free Library Foundation's Kellogg Fund, our community now has access to this valuable—and rarely available—resource in a public library setting.

With the Bloomberg Terminal, you can:

- Review real-time and historical financial data
- Research companies, markets, and investments
- Follow international business and financial news

Reservations:

- The Bloomberg Terminal is available on a first-come, first-served basis for up to two hours per day.
- Library staff can assist with account and password setup. Once set up, users self-navigate the terminal.

Important to note:

- Some Bloomberg pages are print-restricted. Printing is allowed only where Bloomberg permits, and in those cases, functions as on other library computers.
- Exporting data is not permitted. Some information may be saved to a personal Bloomberg account, per Bloomberg's policies.
- No trading is permitted or accessible; this is an educational platform only.
- The Bloomberg Terminal uses a proprietary keyboard with specialized shortcuts.
